Thank you for your willingness to serve the youth in this diocese through these programs! We are thrilled to see the Lord at work in and through you. Please take a moment to consider the following statements and please answer honestly.

Our programs are supported by the Anglican Church, which holds the beliefs outlined below. In order to best serve you as well as these programs, we would like to know more about your own beliefs, openly recognizing each one of us doesn't know everything and is always seeking to grow closer to Christ. Please answer yes/no/I don't know to each of these statements.

Answering 'no' or 'I don't know' will <u>not</u> automatically disable you from serving in these programs. Your honest answers will give us knowledge regarding how we, and your home church, can minister to you. We recognize that everyone sins, including us, and we are grateful for God's grace and salvation through Jesus. But we take seriously the call to leadership in the church and therefore hold the expectation that those in positions of influence need to be sure that what we model for others represents a Christian way of living-out our faith. If there are seasons when leaders are not actively striving to uphold these beliefs, we will come alongside them as they step out of their influential role to seek guidance and accountability.
